Enrollment Requirements

1. Completed Enrollment Form

Must include student's name, age, school/organization (if applicable), and contact information.

2. Signed Nonviolence Pledge

All participants are required to read and sign the NVLA Pledge to uphold the principles of nonviolence throughout the program.

3. Enrollment Fee: \$120 per student

Covers access to the full 12-lesson Masterclass Edition, printable materials, assessments, and certification upon completion.

4. Internet Access

Required for students enrolled in the online edition of the course. Printable packets are available for offline classroom use.

Certification Requirements

To receive the title of Certified Nonviolent Leader, students must:

- Complete all 12 lessons of Project C.H.A.N.G.E.
- Pass each lesson assessment with 100% accuracy (retakes allowed)
- Complete the Pre-Test and Post-Test
- Submit a short final reflection or action plan
- Sign the Nonviolence Pledge (if not already completed)

Upon meeting these requirements, students will be issued an official Certificate of Achievement and added to the NVLA National Registry of Nonviolent Leaders.
